

## Socials and Activities

In addition to our monthly general meeting, our club has an active social and activity calendar.

Our Activity team works diligently to arrange outings to the theatre, car rallies, quiz nights, factory and garden tours, cooking demos, as well as various sporting activities.

The Social team organizes the annual Summer Picnic, Anniversary Dinner and Dance, and Christmas Lunch.

The following social clubs provide opportunities for our members to meet and socialize. Generally the clubs meet once a month and rotate host/hostess duties.

### Books

We have four book clubs that meet to discuss a book chosen by that particular month's host/hostess.

We also have a help yourself book exchange at our general meeting.

### Card and Board Game

We have a variety of card playing clubs: *Bid Euchre*, *Bridge*, *Cribbage*, *Canasta*, and *Euchre* that each meet for healthy competition.

There are two board game clubs: *Jokers* and *Bee Gees*. The Bee Gees play a different game each month chosen by the host/hostess.

### Classical Music

The *Classical Music* club is for those who appreciate and love to listen to and discuss music.

### Crafts

We have a *Knitting* and a *Quilting* club that each meet to show their current projects and share their craft ideas, or go on outings.

### Dining

The *Lunch Bunch* meets at different restaurants after the general meeting.

*Skip the Dishes* and *Saturday Night Live* savours fine dining one evening a month at a local restaurant.

The *Supper Club* arranges dinners that cater to eight people, with each couple (or two singles) responsible for ¼ of the pre-determined menu.

There are two clubs: *Basic* and *Conversation* that provide a non-judgmental and relaxed atmosphere where members can learn/converse in French and have fun.

### Friendship

The friendship club meets for coffee and conversation at Seasons Retirement Home on Bronte Street.

### Hiking

The *Trail Walkers* club hikes easy to moderate trails generally within Halton Region (Conservation areas, regional forest tracts, RBG etc.).

### Movie

The *Oscar Nights* club goes to the Galaxy Cinema, Milton to watch movies. Afterwards, they gather at Turtle Jacks for friendship and to rate the movie(s).

### Nosh
